

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REGISTERED TRUSTEES OF TOGETHER PEOPLE OUTLOOK FOUNDATION (TPOF)

ARTICLE1: NAME AND DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be known as Together People Outlook Foundation (TPOF), herein referred to as 'the Foundation'. TPOF is a non-governmental, non-profit, and non-political organization established to support sustainable community development in the areas of education, agriculture, health, and women and youth empowerment.

ARTICLE2: ADDRESS OF THE ORGANIZATION

The official address of the Foundation shall be:

ARTICLE3: INTERPRETATION

In this Constitution, unless the context otherwise requires, words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine, and the singular shall include the plural. 'Board' means the Board of Trustees, and 'Foundation' means Together People Outlook Foundation (TPOF).

ARTICLE4: LEGAL STATUS

TPOF shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal, capable of suing and being sued in its own name, and of acquiring, holding, and disposing of property, both movable and immovable.

PREAMBLE:

TPOF is established to promote community empowerment and sustainable development through education, health, agriculture, and social programs that uplift vulnerable groups in Malawi.

VISION:

To create a self-sustaining and empowered society where every individual has access to basic needs and opportunities for growth.

MISSION:

To empower communities through education, agriculture, health, and capacity-building initiatives aimed at achieving sustainable development.

ARTICLE5: OBJECTIVES

Main Objective:

To promote sustainable community development and self-reliance among the people of Malawi.

Specific Objectives:

1. To improve access to quality education for children and youth.
2. To promote sustainable agricultural practices among rural farmers.
3. To enhance community health awareness and health care access.
4. To empower women and youth through skills training and entrepreneurship.
5. To collaborate with government and other stakeholders for effective community development.

ARTICLE6: MODUSOPERANDI

TPOF shall operate through community-based programs, partnerships, and projects that are participatory, transparent, and accountable. The Foundation shall establish committees and local structures to implement and monitor activities.

ARTICLE7: POWERS OF THE ORGANIZATION

TPOF shall have the power to raise funds, solicit donations, acquire property, employ staff, and enter into contracts necessary to achieve its objectives.
